

# Lost Creek Ranch 2023 Rates & Policies

#### Rates:

King Half-Duplex \$8,500 based on occupancy of 2

Regular Half- Duplex \$8,200 based on minimum occupancy of 2 and sleeps up to 3
Living Room Cabin \$16,400 based on minimum occupancy of 4 and sleeps up to 8

Additional Guests \$2,000 per additional guest

# Length of Stay:

Arriving Sunday with a check-in of 2pm and departing the ranch Saturday by 11am.

### Season Length:

Our season runs June 4th - September 16th

### **Adults Only Weeks:**

September 3<sup>rd</sup> – September 9<sup>th</sup> September 10<sup>th</sup> – September 16<sup>th</sup>

#### **Policies:**

Rates are based on minimum occupancy according to the room size and a six-night stay.

A 50% deposit is required within 7 days of confirming reservations. Deposits can be paid and mailed by personal check or bank wire. Please note that we do not accept credit cards on deposits.

The Lost Creek Ranch offering and our personal connections we form at the ranch are of great importance to us. For this reason, our preference is to communicate directly with guests.

### **Cancellations:**

All parties are afforded the opportunity to cancel on or before February 1, 2023 with a full refund. After February 1st, Lost Creek Ranch will refund only for the portion of your reservation that we are able to rebook. No credit will be allowed for absences during the reserved time or for departure ahead of the check-out date.

We understand that cancellations arise and will do our best to rebook the cabin with enough notice. If the cabin is unable to be rebooked, guests will forfeit the 50 percent non-refundable deposit unless we are able to refill the entire space.



# Age & Weight Requirements -

- No children younger than 6 years old will be allowed to participate in trail rides\*. Children younger than 6 can
  be enrolled in Kids Club to participate in Wrangler guided lead arounds at the barn.
- All Children under the age of 13 must wear helmets.\*
- Kids Club is geared towards potty trained to 10 years of age and includes outdoor activities as well as indoor activities such as movies and arts and crafts.
- Onsite Caregivers for children under 3 are not available. We are happy to provide references to local nannies and caregivers.
- Children 8 and over can participate in All Day rides and the Shadow Mountain excursion ride.
- Children ages 13 and above can participate in team penning in the arena with cattle.
- Children must be over 30lbs to participate on float trips.
- Our rider weight limit is 250lbs. If you are over this weight limit, please notify the Reservations team so that we can discuss with the Head Wrangler and plan horse assignments and rides accordingly.

### **Included in Your Stay:**

- Lodging and accommodations.
- All meals served at ranch including cookouts.
- Guided Hikes around the ranch and in Bridger Teton National Forest.
- Daily Horseback riding with experienced wranglers.
- Programming for children potty-trained and up including cookouts, hayrides and horses.
- Shooting instruction for skeet range (please note ammunition and clay pigeons are an additional cost).
- Scenic Float trip down the Snake River (one per guest).
- Outdoor heated swimming pool and hot tub.
- Fitness facility with cardio equipment, weight room, sauna, and steam room.
- Once a week laundry service.
- Shuttle service for arrivals and departures to and from JAC, the weekly rodeo, float trips and fishing trips with our contracted guide.

#### Additional Fees:

- Alcoholic Beverages
- Gift Shop purchases
- Spa Services
- Shells, clay targets: \$40 per round for skeet. (Prices subject to change based on availability)
- Third Party Offsite activities such as fly fishing, Yellowstone tours, Whitewater rafting, etc.
- 5% Wyoming Lodging Tax
- 6% Wyoming Sales Tax (on incidentals during your stay)

### A Note on all-inclusive gratuities:

The staff at Lost Creek Ranch are committed to making sure your vacation exceeds your expectations. All staff members (except for Management\*) participate in a tip-sharing pool. Customary gratuity typically ranges between 15-25% and is not included in the rates above but is suggested in recognition of exceptional service.

- Evening activities include presentations by local Astronomer's, Master Naturalist and Horsemanship experts.

## A Note to large groups (more than 8 guests):

We do our best to accommodate large groups and will customize a weekly agenda for you and your friends and family to enjoy ranch activities as a group. Please note, there are some activities that are limited to size due to insurance or staffing availability, these limitations include -

- 8 person trail rides
- 5 person skeet shooting
- 8 person scenic float trips
- 14 person maximum group size for singular table seating in the Dining Room
- 12 person maximum capacity for wagon rides
